**Player Registration:** We remind you that each participant will be required to be registered in the WBF Database and eligible to play for the country they represent. They must sign the WBF Commitment form if they have not done so for a previous event, a copy of which will be made available to them when the team is registered. In addition the parent/guardian of all participating minors must sign the WBF Parental Consent form which will also be sent when the team is registered.

**Anti-Doping Testing:** Note that there will be Anti-Doping tests carried out during the Championships. Please ensure that everyone is aware of this and checks the prohibited list and the anti-doping regulations as the penalties for taking prohibited medication are severe unless a Therapeutic Exemption Certificate (TUE) has been issued. Information about the WBF Anti-Doping Rules, the current Prohibited list and information about obtaining a TUE can be found here: <http://www.worldbridge.org/rules-regulations/anti-doping-regulations/> . If a TUE is required by one of your players please ensure that they apply for it well in advance as it can take some time.


