

Mixed Pairs Format

There will be three stages: Qualification (over two days), Semifinals A&B (over two days), and a one-day Final.

Due to possible drop-ins, it is not currently possible to specify the exact number of qualifiers for each stage; however:

- Semifinals A&B will be split as equally as possible.
- The Final will be played by a total of 26 pairs (see SCoCo).
- There will be no carry-over from one stage to another.

Senior Pairs Format

There will be three stages: Qualification (over two days), Semifinals A&B (over two days), and a one-day Final.

Due to possible drop-ins, it is not currently possible to specify the exact number of qualifiers for each stage; however:

- Semifinals A&B will be split as equally as possible.
- The number of qualifiers for the Final depends on entries and potential drop-ins, but it is expected to be between 14 and 18 pairs (though this is subject to change).
- There will be no carry-over from one stage to another.

Barbados Swiss Cup

There will be three stages: Qualification (over two days), Semifinal (over two days), and a one-day Final.

Due to possible drop-ins, it is not currently possible to specify the exact number of qualifiers for each stage; however:

- The qualifiers for the Semifinal will be roughly half of the total field, including drop-ins.
- The number of qualifiers for the Final depends on entries and potential drop-ins, but in principle, there should be 8.
- There will be no carry-over from one stage to another.
- Teams eliminated at any stage may drop into the BAM.
