JOAN GERARD YOUTH AWARDS

The Joan Gerard Youth Awards aim at rewarding aptitude, fair play, good sportsmanship and a friendly international spirit, rejecting any discrimination. They will be presented every year at the Youth Bridge Teams Championships and at the World Youth Transnational Bridge Championships to a player from each category (U26, U26W, U21, U16, U31).

Each of the attending players, NPCs, coaches, WBF championship officials and members of the staff can nominate one player per category to receive the Joan Gerard Youth Award. No one can nominate players from his/her own country.

The final selection will be made by a Commission composed of the members of the Championship Committee and chaired by the Master of Protocol & Ceremony. The result will be announced and the Joan Gerard Youth Awards presented at the Prize-giving Ceremony.

Declarer ruffed and played two rounds of diamonds, North winning and switching to the ♠J, followed by the ♠4. Declarer won, and played a diamond, South winning as North jettisoned the ♥K. The ♠K and two hearts meant two down, -200.

If West leads a heart, three down is in the air, but after the ♣Q, ducked followed by the ♣2, declarer ruffed and ran the ♥10. East

He won the heart return, ran the ♦J, cashed three more diamonds and advanced the ♣Q, taking 10 tricks, +630 and 13 IMPs to The Deuces, match winners to the tune of 21-4, 16.04-3.96 VP, taking them more than a match clear of the field.

Declarer had to lose a spade, -100 and 12 MPs to Reignwood Juniors, winning 27-3, 17.62-2.38 VP leaving them in second place.



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Matchpoint Moments

At this form of scoring every deal can be interesting. Here is a selection of challenging ones from the opening round of the Pairs qualification.

A number of pairs reached 4♥ on this deal, but in the U21 event only three pairs managed to make it.

If West leads the ♦A and then plays two rounds of clubs declarer put sup dummy's ♣Q and ruffs East's ♣K. The ♥K discloses the 5-0 split and now declarer runs the ♥10, plays a diamond to the king, pitches a spade on the ♣Q, plays the ♠J to the queen, pitches a diamond on the ♠A and with seven tricks in the bag can crossruff for three more.

An initial heart lead is a killer.

Scoring +420 was worth 47/7, while one down, -50 was 31/23.

The top score went to Zhaofeng Wang and Lysandra Zheng, who doubled 2♠ by East. That was always going to be at least three down, but declarer did not time the play to perfection and -800 meant 54/0.

Many pairs attempted a slam on this deal, votes going to 6♣, 6♦, 6♠, 6NT, 7♣ and 7NT. Although no slam should make, 6♣ will get home if South leads the ♠A and 6♦ will make if the ♠A is taken at trick one.

A heart/diamond/club lead allows declarer to adopt some variation of winning, cashing the top diamonds, overtaking the ♣10 and playing winning clubs, disposing of all dummy's losers. +920 was worth 51/3.

After that playing in 3NT was the way to go, +460 being worth 37-17.

North led the ♠7 and declarer took South's ♠10 with the ♠K, played a diamond to the queen, a heart to the ten and the ♣10 to dummy's ♣K. When that held a second heart finesse was followed by three more hearts. Now the ♦K should lead to 10 tricks, but declarer continued with the ♦4 and North correctly took the ♦A, but then, instead of exiting with a diamond to endplay declarer, cashed the other two aces, giving declarer +430 and 79.80/8.20.

Losing 400 was not much better, 65.48/22.52.

The pairs who were allowed to play in 4♥ all made at least 10 tricks, +620 being worth

66.50/21.50. If West is the declarer it would asking a lot for North to lead a low club, but if East is at the helm South might try the ♠A, planning to switch to a diamond if partner discourages. That way 4♥ will fail. A number of pairs saved in 4♠ and -500 gave NS 56.27/31.73.

If NS play in spades, East needs to find a diamond lead to hold declarer to 11 tricks. If East starts with the ♣A declarer ruffs, cashes the top spades and plays a heart to the king and a heart. If declarer puts up an honour that's 11 tricks, while ducking the second round gets you 12.

Those players who got the lead of the ♥A had an easy route to 12 tricks, but a few did make 12 after the lead of the ♣A – well done to them.

2 pairs bid 6♠, and going down after the lead of the ♣A meant only 1.05/86.95.

Making 4♠xx for +1280 gave Yijie Zhu and Li Minglang 87.98/.02.

Virtually everyone was in 3NT played by West.

At IMPs North would probably lead a club, but at matchpoints it might easily cost a trick. The modern tendency is to look for a safe, passive lead, and here a heart fits the bill, provided partner is not tempted to put up the ♥K.

Holding declarer to nine tricks was worth 69.57/18.43.

the ♠J and played a heart to the queen. A spade to the ten saw North win and switch to the ♦9. Declarer elected to duck twice, and finished one down. It would not have helped to win the second diamond and play a spade as North would win and exit with a club. If declarer then tries a top heart North wins and locks declarer in hand with a heart, South scoring a diamond at the end.

The simple way to avoid this is for declarer to unblock the ♣K at trick two.

If East is the declarer and South leads the ♦K declarer needs to win the second round of the suit (easier if South has opened 2♦). Declarer can run the ♠9, win the clubs return in dummy, unblock the clubs and should have no trouble securing nine tricks. Going down in 3NT meant only 12.30/75.70 while +400 was worth 65.48/22.52.

When South led the ♥10 declarer won with dummy's ♥K, cashed the top diamonds discarding clubs and played the ♠9. North took the ♦A and exited with the ♥9 but declarer won with the ♥Q, cashed the ♠K, ruffed a spade, cashed the ♥J and claimed the rest, +680 and 74.68/13.32.

Larry Cohen has pointed out that because of the light openings and wafter this responses that form part of the current game, the 1NT overcall in the 'sandwich' position needs to be strong. North though that was the case here.

West cashed the ♦A and when East discarded the ♠10 he continued with the ♦6, East ruffing and playing two rounds of hearts. West won with the ♥J and returned the ♦3, East ruffing and playing the ♥7. Declarer ruffed and tried a spade to the jack, East winning and returning the ♠2 for West to ruff. West cashed the ♦K and waited to score the ♣K for six down, -1400 scoring 83.89/4.11.

It was not a top because two pairs bid and made 6♥, worth 86.95/1.05.



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Teams Finals

Round Robin Rounds 4 and 6

Both these rounds mainly consisted of flat boards, not worth reporting. As always, there was an exception or two so below are some boards from these two rounds.

I will start with a curiosity. I would very much have loved to have known the auction and play on board 27

At one table in the U26, C. L. A. Hui and J. Yan reached 4♠xx and made it, too, for the remarkable score of +880. That's all I can tell you about the hand...

The last board of this same set was more interesting.

The popular contracts in N/S were 3NT and 4♥. At a number of tables, West opened the bidding. This proved highly effective when East responded 1NT and N/S both felt they were not strong enough to take any action. 1NT in E/W went three off for +150 to N/S but this was not a good result if the team-mates would concede 600 in 3NT.

Still, making 3NT on a diamond lead is far from easy. On this lead, most declarers went down. It is really asking too much to finesse the ♥Q through East. A spade lead, the alternative at some tables, gives declarer a trick but also enables West to clear the spades while the ♦A is still there. I have not seen any declarer who finessed the ♥Q through East, very much an anti-percentage play IMHO.

Over now to a few boards from round 6 of the Round Robin.

The match between Zhejiang Warhorse and Poland in the women's U26 ended in 7-7 over the allotted 7 boards. The Chinese scored all their IMPs on this board...

North had not bothered to double with her fine trump holding but there was not very much the defence could have done better. Declarer will always come to eight tricks because North has to follow suit from time to time. Warhorse +200.

The Poles in N/S were less ambitious than their counterparts but they, too, had to follow suit from time to time. That's why 4♥ went down as well for another +100 and 7 IMPs to Zhejiang Warhorse. It should be added, however, that the Polish squad won the women's event nevertheless.

Yes, the popular or even normal contract was 4♠ by North.

No, I won't dwell upon the table where East led the ♣A, thus giving declarer a task not worth mentioning. The interesting situation arises when East makes the normal enough lead of the ♦J.

Here are some examples of what might happen and in fact did happen after this lead.

Some declarers went down in straightforward fashion. They won the ♦K in hand and immediately took the heart finesse. West would then win his ♥K and return a club. Curtains.

Some others made a good start when they shed a club from hand on a top diamond in dummy. But what next? If you exit with a club, East might win and return a low trump. The defence then can play two more rounds of trumps when in with the ♥K. I saw one table where this defence was found. Well done, team Shqy!



The Hong Kong Youngsters showed the other side of the coin. After three rounds of diamonds, their declarer (Shek) simply played ♥A, ♥Q. This way, he would always be able to ruff his losing heart before the rats would appear □.

On this board, at the same table I saw a result I could not understand. How can East make an overtrick in 4♥ in spite of his four possible losers? I could imagine that the defence did not attack the minors in proper order, thus enabling declarer to get rid of just one loser in time, but two??

South had made the very good lead of a low diamond, to pave the way for beating the contract. The only thing the defenders have to do now is shift to clubs as soon as they get the lead in spades. A diamond to the ♦Q followed by a club shift is also good enough. When North won the first spade with his ♠K and exited in trumps instead, South had to play a club when he was next in with the ♠A because he wanted to defeat the contract and the overtrick did not matter. Only now, I understood why it was -650.

This was an expensive defensive mistake because at the other table, the auction had been like this:
